MEET THE TEAM - SUSIE CLEGG, CARE COORDINATOR

My name is Susie Clegg and I am the Care Co-ordinator at Vauxhall Primary Health Care.

I have worked at Vauxhall for over 8 years. Started as data quality officer but took on the role as care co-ordinator 3 years ago and really enjoy it.



The role of Care Co-ordinator is very diverse which means not only do I still get to do data quality work which means I get to work closely with nurses and GP's ensuring information documented is coded correctly, but, I also get to interact with Patients either face to face, via telephone or sms when inviting them into their long term health condition annual reviews.

I am involved in the care of our more vulnerable patients ensuring they are seen and fully reviewed by a GP in an environment in which they are comfortable and feel safe. I have done home visits to patients who do not interact with the surgery and try to work with them to find a solution to help them feel comfortable having their review. Other work I am involved in is Cancer Care and I talk to newly diagnosed cancer patients offering support from other agencies who can help with emotional, financial, social, family support and much more.

In the last 18 months I have trained to become a phlebotomist, I have done my Diabetic foot screening training, Hypertension Monitoring training and immunisation training so I can be more interactive with patients and offer more support to both patients and colleagues at Vauxhall Primary Care.
